Musings of a Consultant

We are all pretty comfortable with flat panel displays by now, and most broadcasters have them in locations beyond the lobby and GM's office. But how comfortable are you with the pending death of the CRT?

California now considers CRT's hazardous waste and charges a recycling fee at the time of purchase. It is a matter of time before all CRTs disappear. Sony closed the glass plant in Westmoreland when it no longer had a need for tubes for projection TVs. It is harder to find CRTs every day now, and soon we will be forced to match cameras on new era displays.

LCDs and PDP (plasma display panels) both have strengths and issues making them less than ideal for control room usage.

In the future the SED, Surface-conduction Electron-emitter Display, looks like the strongest long term candidate. Think of it as a 2" thick perfectly flat CRT with solid state emitters behind every pixel. Colorimetry and contrast are fantastic and power consumption is reported to be below LCD displays. Canon and Toshiba will be bringing them to market this calendar year. Expect at least one professional monitor supplier to offer them quickly.

CORRECTION



From Greater Pgh. Airport

Take Parkway West (Rt. 60 South) 4 miles.
Get off at the Rt. 60 South (Crafton) exit. Exit 1B.
At the Third set of red lights, make a right turn
onto Campbells Run Road. (The set of
lights before SHEETZ GAS Station)
The Red Bull is about 500 yards down
Campbells Run Road on the right hand
side. (We are right next to the Country Inn
& Suites.)

From Downtown Pittsburgh

Go through the Fort Pitt Tunnels.
Follow the Parkway West for about 8 miles.
Get off at the Crafton Rt. 60 exit.
The Red Bull Inn is directly on your left
beside the exit ramp.
